Proposal for draft Corrigendum 2 to Supplement 9 to Regulation No. 98

Submitted by the expert from the Working Party "Brussels 1952" \*/

The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the Working party "Brussels 1952" (GTB) in order to correct the inconsistency of the marking requirement related to Light Emitting Diode (LED) modules in Regulations Nos. 19, 98 and 112. The modifications to the current text of the Regulation (including Supplement 10 to the original version) are marked in bold characters.

\*/ In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2006-2010 (ECE/TRANS/166/Add.1, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

A. PROPOSAL

Insert new paragraph 3.8., to read:

**"3.8. If an electronic light source control gear which is not part of a LED module is used to operate a LED module(s), it shall be marked with its specific identification code(s), the rated input voltage and wattage."**

B. JUSTIFICATION

This proposal is an editorial correction to align the marking requirements for LED modules and light source control gear in Regulation 98 with those in Regulation No. 112. Whereas the proposal is purely editorial, it is proposed to adopt it as a Corrigendum.
