1. Opening of the meeting

In carrying out its tasks, the Expert Group will follow the provisions of paragraph 7 of Economic and Social Council resolution 2007/40, in which the Council requested the Expert Group to develop proposals for the development of a voluntary global financial mechanism/portfolio approach/forest financing framework, and invited the Collaborative Partnership on Forests to assist in the development of those proposals.
