TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION AMONG DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Letter dated 12 April 1976 from the Permanent
Representative of Argentina to the United
Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to address you in connexion with General Assembly resolution 3461 (XXX) on technical co-operation among developing countries, in particular paragraph 9 of that resolution.

In that paragraph, the General Assembly took note with appreciation of the offer made by my country to act as host of the United Nations Conference on Technical Co-operation among Developing Countries to be organized by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) under the auspices of the United Nations.

In that connexion, I am pleased, by this letter, to formalize the invitation of the Argentine Government and, at the same time, to tell you that the authorities of my country are aware of the practice established in accordance with General Assembly resolution 2609 (XXIV) with regard to the additional costs incurred whenever a meeting is held away from United Nations Headquarters.

I would be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly under item 67 of the preliminary list of items to be included in the provisional agenda of the thirty-first session.
