The first sentence *should read*

Should the General Assembly decide to extend the pension scheme currently applicable to the permanent judges of the two Tribunals (as described in paragraphs 15-17 above) to the ad litem judges with more than three years of continuous service, the related budgetary implications are estimated at \$421,300 for the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda and \$346,566 for the International Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia annually, based on the current terms of service of the ad litem judges.
