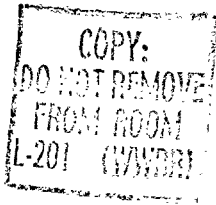

ORGANIZATION OF WORK

The CHAIRMAN said that the Committee had planned at the current meeting to begin consideration of item 128, entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations", which had been included in the agenda of the General Assembly at the request of 29 States Members of the Asian Group. He had been informed, however, that the Asian Group had not yet completed its consultations. It would therefore seem preferable to postpone the debate on the item until the following meeting, during which the Committee would also resume consideration of item 123.
