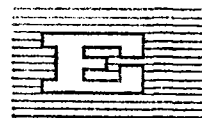
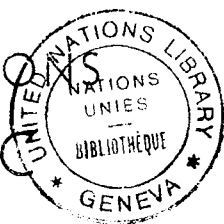

LISTS OF THOSE ALLEGEDLY RESPONSIBLE FOR CRIMES OF  
APARTHEID AND OF THOSE WHOSE ACTIVITIES CONSTITUTE  
ASSISTANCE TO RACIST REGIMES

1. On page 5 of the Secretary-General's note as to "further developments" (E/CN.4/Sub.2/380, 15 July 1977, para. 15), we learn of the request that competent United Nations organs, including this Sub-Commission, provide to the Commission on Human Rights information relevant to the preparation of a list of individuals, organizations, institutions and representatives of States which are alleged to be responsible for crimes enumerated in article II of the Convention on the Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of Apartheid.
2. That list may overlap, in part, the "provisional general list" described in the second paragraph on page 8 of this Sub-Commission's provisional agenda (E/CN.4/Sub.2/379).
3. Would it not be desirable at this session to co-ordinate work on the lists, thus (pursuant to the request of each body) assisting both the General Assembly next Fall and the Commission on Human Rights next Spring?
