The present map reflects information concerning Israeli settlements which has been submitted to the Special Committee to Investigate Israeli Practices Affecting the Human Rights of the Palestinian People and Other Arabs of the Occupied Territories.

The designations employed and the presentation of material on this map do not imply the expression of any opinion whatsoever on the part of the Special Committee or the Secretariat of the United Nations concerning the legal status of any country, territory, city or area or of its authorities, or concerning the delimitation of its frontiers or boundaries.

A number of settlements in the Occupied Territories were reported to have been expanded since the 25th report of the Special Committee (A/48/557). For ease of reference, these settlements have been marked in red color. Among the settlements in the West Bank which were established but not located, Oranit was said to have been expanded. Among the settlements in the Gaza Strip which were established but not located, Guch Katif and Nissanit have reportedly been expanded.
