Corrigendum

Paragraph I(68) of Annex 1 to the above document gave only an extract of article 2 of the "Boundary Treaty between the Kingdom of Iraq and the Empire of Iran, signed at Teheran on July 4th, 1937". By note verbale, dated 21 April 1969, the Permanent Mission of Iraq requested that the full article should be reproduced in Annex 1 of the document.

Paragraph I(68) should be replaced by the following paragraph, which reproduces the complete text of article 2 of the Treaty as it appears in volume No. 4423 of the League of Nations Treaty Series, published in 1938.

"(68) 4 July 1937: Boundary Treaty between the Kingdom of Irak  
and the Empire of Iran

Article 2

At the extreme point of the island of Choteit (being approximately latitude 30°17'25" North, longitude 48°19'28" East), the frontier shall run perpendicularly from low water mark to the thalweg of the Shatt-el-Arab, and shall follow the same as far as a point opposite the present Jetty No. I at Abadan (being approximately latitude 30°20'8.4" North, longitude 48°16'13" East). From this point, it shall return to low water mark, and follow the frontier line indicated in the 1914 Minutes."
