Agenda item 79QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS
OF THE UNITED NATIONSReport of the Special Political CommitteeRapporteur: Mr. Jorge Eduardo CHEN CHARPENTIER (Mexico)

1. The item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" was included in the provisional agenda of the thirty-ninth session of the General Assembly in accordance with Assembly decision 38/423 of 15 December 1983.
2. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1984, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Special Political Committee.
3. At the 28th meeting of the Special Political Committee, on 12 November, the Chairman proposed that, as no member of the Committee had requested to speak on the item, consideration of it should be deferred until the fortieth session.
4. In the absence of any objection, it was so decided.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL POLITICAL COMMITTEE

5. The Special Political Committee recommends that the General Assembly should include in the provisional agenda of its fortieth session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations".
