Corrigendum

1. **Paragraph 5, second sentence**

After “mainly” *replace* the rest of the text of that sentence with the following:

warming effect. Because sulphate aerosols have a mainly cooling effect, reducing these emissions has unmasked underlying anthropogenic climate change that would have occurred in the absence of these emissions.

2. **Paragraph 25, second sentence**

for “cooling effect” read “warming effect”

3. **Paragraph 25, third sentence**
