Paragraph 33 *should read*

33. **Option 1:** In addition, Annex I Parties should provide information on the following indirect GHGs: carbon monoxide (CO), nitrogen oxides (NO_x) and non-methane volatile organic compounds (NMVOCs), as well as sulphur oxides (SO_x). [Annex I Parties [shall][should [as a memo item]] report indirect CO₂ [emissions] from the atmospheric oxidation of CH₄, CO and NMVOCs [and indirect N₂O emissions resulting from the nitrogen deposition of all anthropogenic sources of NO_x and NH₃]. In reporting indirect [emissions][CO₂], Annex I Parties should avoid double counting and report indirect CO₂ [emissions] only for those categories for which the carbon is not already covered by the assumptions and approximations made in estimating CO₂ emissions. [These estimates should not be included in national totals but be reported separately.]]
