Statement submitted by Children of the World: Regional Public Charitable Fund of Assistance to Cultural and Sports Development of Children and Young People, a non-governmental organization in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council

The Secretary-General has received the following statement, which is being circulated in accordance with paragraphs 30 and 31 of Economic and Social Council resolution 1996/31.

Statement*

The positive development of the world requires deployment of a global project aimed at all people of our planet, united by a common project and a single idea under the auspices of the United Nations Economic and Social Council.

The Foundation has created a cultural and recreation movement “Planet Peoples’ Games” for all people of our planet, in order to teach people the basics of a healthy lifestyle. This wellness movement is of interest to all peoples and all countries. Today, this movement involves more than 10 million people. This movement has not only health orientation, but also learning character, learning the basics of a healthy lifestyle for children, youth and adults.

Objectives of the worldwide movement: (a) Collective and individual training for youth and adults about the basics of a healthy lifestyle; (b) Developing a global mechanism to attract people of the world to the movement for a healthy lifestyle; (c) Unification of the peoples of the world under a single idea, common to all countries, in the movement for a healthy lifestyle.

Proposals: (a) Expand the global movement “Planet Peoples’ Games” by learning the basics of a healthy lifestyle in our planet, regardless of colour, creed or financial prosperity under the auspices of the Council; (b) Provide an opportunity for the Fund “Children of the World” to address a meeting of the Council with the participation of United Nations Member States with the subject: “The global movement for a healthy lifestyle ‘Planet Peoples’ Games’.” In the case of a positive decision, to include this motion in a General Assembly resolution.
