Organization of the session

A. Opening and duration of the session

1. The Statistical Commission held its forty-third session at United Nations Headquarters from 28 February to 2 March 2012. The Commission held six meetings.

B. Attendance

2. The session was attended by the representatives of the 24 States members of the Commission. Also in attendance were observers for other States Members of the United Nations and for non-Member States, representatives of United Nations system organizations and observers for intergovernmental, non-governmental and other organizations. D. Agenda and organization of work
