The following further reply has been received to the inquiry dispatched to Governments in accordance with paragraph 1 of resolution 1420 (XLVI) of the Economic and Social Council:

GREECE

The provisions of the Greek Constitution, as well as those of the Greek Penal Code, are in keeping with the spirit of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide, providing ample safeguards for the prevention and punishment of this crime.

Consequently, there has been no need of adopting new legislative measures to this effect.
