WORLD CAMPAIGN FOR UNIVERSAL LITERACY

Page 13, under the heading "The scope of the problem. Adult illiteracy", sixth sentence:

Delete the clause "while Bulgaria's 22 per cent refers to people 'over 15 years old'".

Page 16, under the heading "History of adult literacy education in certain Member States":

Add the following sentence at the end of the third paragraph: "Bulgaria also reported that by 1953 illiteracy had been virtually eliminated among the country's working population".

Page 17, under the heading "Organization of literacy courses", second paragraph:

Change "seven-eighths" to read "seven or eight".
