Paragraph 30

The first two sentences *should read*

In their internal waters, coastal States enjoy full sovereignty (article 2) and are free to regulate the placing of marine renewable energy facilities, subject to the obligation to protect and preserve the marine environment (see below). Where the establishment of a straight baseline has the effect of enclosing as internal waters areas which had not previously been considered as such, a right of innocent passage as provided for in the Convention shall also exist in those waters (article 8, paragraph 2).
