



LAWS AND REGULATIONS

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATIES ON NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES

In accordance with the relevant articles of the international treaties on narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative texts.

CYPRUS

THE NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1986

In exercise of the powers vested in it under sections 8, 11, 28, 35 and 36 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Laws, 1977 ¹/₁ to 1983, the Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Amendment) Regulations, 1986 and shall be read as one with the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Regulations 1979 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"). The principal regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Regulations 1979 and 1986.

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following new paragraphs 1A and 1B:

- "1A. Propiram preparations which contain no more than 100 milligrams propiram, calculated as base, per dosage unit and at least equal quantity of methylcellulose.
- "1B. Dextropropoxyphene preparations for oral administration which contain not more than 135 milligrams dextropropoxyphene calculated as base per dosage unit or preparations with a concentration not greater than 2.5 per centum on non-divisible preparations, provided that such preparations do not contain any controlled substance in accordance with the Convention on Psychotropic Substances, 1971."

3. Paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by the addition, immediately after the word "Acetorphine" of the word "Alfentanil", immediately after the word "Oxymorphone" of the word "Pentazocine", immediately after the word "Racemorphan" of the word "Sulfentanyl" and immediately after the word "Thebaine" of the word "Tilidine".

4. Paragraph 6 of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by the addition, immediately after the word "Dexamphetamine" of the word "Dextropropoxyphene", immediately after the word "Ethylmorphine" of the word "Mecloqualone" and immediately after the word "Norcodeine" of the word "Phencyclidine".

5. Paragraph 1 of the Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by the addition, immediately after the word "Bufotenine" of the word "DMHP", immediately after the words "Concentrates of poppy straw" of the word "Eticyclidine", immediately after the word "Mescaline" of the word "Parahexyl", immediately after the words "Raw opium" of the word "Rolicyclidine", and immediately after the word "Psilocin" of the words "Psilocybine" and "Tenocyclidine".

6. Paragraph 1 of the Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by the addition, immediately after the word "Oxycodone", of the word "Pentazocine".

7. Paragraph 1 of the Seventh Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby deleted and substituted with the following paragraph:

"1. The following substances and products:
