**Letter dated 17 September 2012 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i.  
of the Permanent Mission of South Sudan to the United Nations  
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I regret to inform you that while we are engaged in the negotiations aimed at finding a lasting settlement to the outstanding issues in Addis Ababa, we have learned about the unfortunate violation by the Republic of the Sudan of our airspace, which occurred on 12 September 2012 in Unity State.

My Government calls on the Security Council to condemn the Sudan's continued air incursions and to repeat its demand that the Sudan must stop further military activities. My Government has welcomed the resumption of talks under the auspices of the African Union High-level Implementation Panel, and wishes to carry on constructively and not under threat.

I would be most grateful if the present letter could be circulated to the members of the Security Council as a document of the Council.
