Letter dated 2 October 2012 from the Permanent Representative of the Sudan to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

Further to my letter dated 1 October 2012 through which I relayed the copies of the agreements signed between the Government of the Republic of the Sudan and the Government of the Republic of South Sudan (S/2012/733), I regrettably convey to you that the Sudan People's Liberation Movement Northern Sector (SPLM-N), concurrently with the promising environment created after the signing of the said agreements, has issued a statement implicitly threatening the implementation of the Security Agreement between the Government of the Republic of the Sudan and the Government of the Republic of South Sudan.

Unfortunately, the above-mentioned statement may negatively impact the security and humanitarian situations in the two States of South Kordofan and the Blue Nile.

While conveying this information, the Security Council is fervently requested to urgently send a strong message and pressurize the Sudan People's Liberation Movement Northern Sector (SPLM-N), not to pose hurdles before the implementation of the agreements signed between the two Governments.

You are kindly requested to circulate this letter as a document of the Security Council.
