Mr. Abram: Suggested Draft for United Nations Convention on the  
Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination

(Addendum)

Article IX

1. Each State Party shall consider and declare all incitement to racial hatred and discrimination resulting in or likely to cause acts of violence, whether by individuals or organizations, as an offence against society and punishable under law.
2. No State Party shall permit its officials or any agency or organization supported in whole or in part by government funds to promote and incite racial hatred, nor shall it grant a franchise or license to any agency, organization, group or individual for the purpose of promoting and inciting to racial hatred.
3. Each State Party shall establish a national policy designed to eradicate all incitement to discrimination and racial hatred, and to assure equal treatment for all persons under its jurisdiction.
4. Each State Party shall provide remedial relief for any individual who has suffered substantial harm as the result of racial violence, hatred or discrimination.
