## **Observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly**

### **Report of the Sixth Committee**

*Rapporteur:* Mr. **Pham** Quang Hieu (Viet Nam)

1. The item entitled “Observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly” was included in the agenda of the sixty-seventh session of the General Assembly pursuant to Assembly decision 66/530 of 9 December 2011.
2. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2012, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.
3. The Sixth Committee considered the item at its 11th and 25th meetings, on 16 October and 16 November 2012. The views of the representatives who spoke during the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.6/67/SR.11 and 25).
4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a letter dated 10 August 2011 from the Permanent Representatives of Cambodia, Japan, Nepal, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea and Viet Nam to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General (A/66/198).
5. At the 11th meeting, on 16 October, the representative of the Philippines, on behalf of Cambodia, Japan, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea and Viet Nam, introduced the item entitled “Observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly”.
6. At the 25th meeting, on 16 November, the representative of the Philippines, on behalf of Cambodia, Japan, Nepal, Pakistan, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea and Viet Nam, proposed that the Committee defer a decision on the request for observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly to the sixty-eighth session of the Assembly.
7. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted a draft decision without a vote (see para. 8).



## **Recommendation of the Sixth Committee**

8. The Sixth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

### **Observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly**

The General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Sixth Committee, decides to defer a decision on the request for observer status for the International Conference of Asian Political Parties in the General Assembly<sup>1</sup> to the sixty-eighth session of the Assembly.
