Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.11Report of the Fifth CommitteeRapporteur: Mr. Ali Achraf MOJTAHED (Islamic Republic of Iran)

1. At its 25th meeting, on 12 November 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/34) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/39/L.11.
