#### Programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee (A/39/776, para. 13)

#### Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 41st meeting, on 4 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/68) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/39/776). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.41).

#### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 82 to 13, with 7 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 13 of its report (A/39/776), conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$430,800. The actual additional appropriations that might be

required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.

4. The voting was as follows:

Against: Belgium, Canada, Denmark, France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Israel, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Brazil, Chile, Ireland, New Zealand, Spain, Sweden.
