Report of the Secretary-General concerning the credentials of the representatives and deputies and alternate representatives of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 2013-2014

1. At its 27th plenary meeting, on 18 October 2012, the General Assembly elected Argentina, Australia, Luxembourg, the Republic of Korea and Rwanda as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years beginning on 1 January 2013.
