At the outset, I should like to express my sincere thanks and that of the people and Government of Yemen for having set aside some of your valuable time to visit Yemen.

Your historic visit to Yemen was a clear expression of your continued support for the process of political transition in our country. It also underscored the crucial role the Security Council, the members of which were unanimous in wishing to assist the Yemeni people to reach agreement on the importance of arriving at a peaceful resolution to the grave crisis that was rocking the country.

Based on the discussions that took place during your most recent visit, I should like to ask once again, on behalf of the people and Government of Yemen, that the Security Council remain actively seized of the situation in Yemen and take the measures it deems necessary to implement completely and effectively resolutions 2014 (2011) and 2051 (2012), as well as the agreement on the transfer of power, in accordance with the spirit of the Gulf Cooperation Council initiative and its implementing mechanism.

I should also like to reiterate that the Yemeni Government has full confidence in the United Nations and the probity and professionalism of its Secretary-General, Mr. Ban Ki-moon, and his Special Adviser on Yemen, Mr. Jamal Benomar.
