Programme budget implications of draft resolution K recommended
by the Special Political Committee (A/39/715, para. 35)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 41st meeting, on 4 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/47) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution K recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 35 of its report (A/39/715). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.41).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 92 to 2, with 6 abstentions to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution K recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 35 of its report (A/39/715), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.

4. The voting was as follows:

In favour: Algeria, Argentina, Bahamas, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Belgium, Benin, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, Burma, Burundi, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Cameroon, Central African Republic, China, Congo, Costa Rica, Cuba, Democratic Yemen, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, Finland, France, German Democratic Republic, Ghana, Greece, Honduras, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Iraq, Ireland, Italy, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Japan, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Liberia, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Malaysia, Maldives, Mali, Mexico, Mongolia, Morocco, New Zealand, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Singapore, Somalia, Spain, Sri Lanka, Swaziland, Sweden, Syrian Arab Republic, Thailand, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Arab Emirates, United Republic of Tanzania, Venezuela, Viet Nam, Yemen, Yugoslavia, Zaire, Zambia.

Against: Israel, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Canada, Chile, Germany, Federal Republic of, Netherlands, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

5. The representative of Czechoslovakia indicated subsequently that he had intended to vote in favour.
