## CORRIGENDA TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE FOURTEENTH MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York,  
on Tuesday, 29 August 1950, at 3 p.m.Page 12Paragraph 33: Replace this paragraph by the following:

"33. Mr. LOPEZ (Philippines) noted that although the Philippines had one of the best agricultural colleges open to indigenous and foreign students alike, agricultural development was somewhat retarded."

Page 15Paragraph 47: Replace this paragraph by the following:

"47. Mr. STEYAERT (Belgium) stated that the Belgian Government did not intend to limit its efforts to the training of auxiliary personnel in the agricultural field, as indicated in document A/AC.35/L.6, paragraphs 23 to 25. Consideration was also being given to the training of fully qualified technicians, on the university level. For that purpose, a school of Agriculture would be added to the University Centre of Kisantu, in the Belgian Congo."
