REPORT ON CONSULTATION BETWEEN THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
AND THE CHAIRMEN OF THE FIRST AND THIRD COMMITTEES
CONCERNING ITEM 6 ON THE SUPPLEMENTARY LIST
DRAFT DECLARATION ON FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHTS
AND FREEDOMS AND ON THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF STATES

(Item Proposed By Panama)

At the twentieth meeting of the General Committee the Secretary-General was requested to consult with the Chairmen of the First and the Third Committee with regard to Item 6 on the Supplementary entitled "Draft declaration on fundamental human rights and freedoms and on the rights and duties of states." (Item proposed by Panama). The Secretary-General held consultation with the Chairmen of the committees on 23 October and it was agreed that that part of the item concerning the rights and duties of states (Draft declaration of the rights and duties of states, Document A/19) should be referred to Committee 1. It was further agreed that that part of the item concerning fundamental human rights and freedoms (Statement of essential human rights presented by the Delegation of Panama, Document A/143) should be referred both to Committee 1 and Committee 3 for general discussion, the Chairmen of the Committees determining the method of joint consideration of that part of the item.
