Request from the Delegation for Lebanon for the
inclusion of an additional item in the Agenda

The following letter has been received from the Delegation for Lebanon:

November 2, 1946

Excellency,

Believing that the activity of universities, scholars, and students throughout the world is of the utmost importance for the maintenance and furtherance of international peace and security, I have the honour to inform your Excellency that the Chairman of my Delegation has authorized me to request the inclusion of the following item in the Agenda of the present session of the General Assembly, under Article 13, paragraph 1(b) of the Charter:

To initiate studies and make recommendations concerning the possibility of the creation of a World University Alliance through which the universities, scholars, and students of the United Nations could collaborate with the United Nations, offering the results of their research and study as their benevolent contribution towards the achievement of the purposes and principles of the Charter.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
