Programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee (A/39/759, para. 9)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 45th meeting, on 11 December 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/82) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/39/759). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.

2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.45).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 75 to 16, with 14 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/39/759), conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$456,700. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.

4. The voting was as follows:

Against: Belgium, Bulgaria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Czechoslovakia, France, German Democratic Republic, Germany, Federal Republic of, Hungary, Italy, Mongolia, Netherlands, Portugal, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Austria, Canada, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, Norway, Spain, Sweden, Viet Nam.
