AND OTHER APPOINTMENTSAppointment of members of the Joint Inspection UnitNote by the Secretary-General

1. Article 4, paragraph 2, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit provides as follows:

"Article 4

"1. ...

"2. An Inspector elected to replace one whose term of office has not expired shall hold office for the remainder of that term, provided it is not less than three years. Otherwise the duration of the appointment will be for a full term."

2. The Secretary-General regrets to inform the General Assembly of the death, on 19 December 1984, of Mr. Toman Hutagalung (Indonesia), whose term of office was due to expire on 31 December 1987. In the circumstances, the General Assembly will be required to appoint a person to replace the late Mr. Hutagalung. The person so appointed will serve for a period of five years, ending on 31 December 1989.

3. As provided in article 3, paragraph 3, of the Unit's statute, the procedure for the replacement of the Inspectors whose terms of office have expired or who have resigned or otherwise ceased to be members of the Unit shall be governed by the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of the same article, the text of which has been reproduced in document A/39/107.
