Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 32nd meeting, on 21 November 1984, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/37) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/39/654). The report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/39/SR.32).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 85 to 9, with 11 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 9 of its report (A/39/654), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.

4. The voting was as follows:

Against: Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Federal Republic of, Israel, Italy, Netherlands, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.

Abstaining: Australia, Austria, Denmark, Finland, Greece, Ireland, Japan, New Zealand, Portugal, Spain, Sweden.
