GENERAL AND COMPLETE DISARMAMENT: INTERNATIONAL ARMS TRANSFERS

Costa Rica: draft resolutionInternational arms transfersThe General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 43/75 I of 7 December 1988, particularly paragraph 1 thereof,

Taking into account the disarmament priorities outlined in paragraph 45 of the Final Document of the Tenth Special Session of the General Assembly, 1/

Bearing in mind that international arms transfers involve not only conventional but also non-conventional armaments, including nuclear weapons,

Concerned that international arms transfers are a central factor in the proliferation of all types of armaments, particularly non-conventional armaments, including nuclear weapons,

1. Reaffirms its conviction that arms transfers in all their aspects deserve serious consideration by the international community;

2. Requests the Disarmament Commission to consider the subject of international transfers of non-conventional armaments, including nuclear weapons, during the deliberations at its next substantive session in 1990:

3. Urges the Conference on Disarmament to consider the issue of international transfers of non conventional arms, including nuclear weapons, during the negotiations at its session in 1990;

4. Decides to include the question of international transfers of non-conventional arms, including nuclear weapons, in the provisional agenda of its forty-fifth session under the item entitled "International arms transfers".
