Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the Secretary-General

1. By its resolution 68/307, the General Assembly decided to establish, at its sixty-ninth session, an ad hoc working group on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States.
2. In paragraph 5 of the same resolution, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to submit an update on the provisions of the Assembly resolutions on revitalization addressed to the Secretariat for implementation that had not been implemented, with an indication of the constraints and reasons behind any lack of implementation, for further consideration by the Ad Hoc Working Group at the sixty-ninth session.
3. In response to a similar request in paragraph 3 of resolution 67/297, the Secretary-General had informed the General Assembly, in his report on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly of 27 February 2014 ([A/68/774](#)) that all provisions of the resolutions on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly addressed to the Secretariat had been implemented in full.
4. Since that time, the General Assembly by resolution 68/307 has given one new mandate to the Secretariat for implementation (see the annex to the present report).
