**Identical letters dated 11 May 2015 from the Permanent  
Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the  
Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council**

On instructions from my Government, I wish to inform that, at 1040 hours on 14 April 2015, in the Hamra area on the outskirts of Aytarun, a landmine left behind by the Israeli enemy exploded, severing the left leg of the civilian Muhammad Ibrahim Murad. The victim was taken to Salah Ghandur Hospital in Bint Jubayl.

I should like to reiterate that my Government honours its commitments under international resolutions. On behalf of my Government, I call on the Security Council to condemn this attack in the strongest possible terms and compel Israel to bring an end to its violations of Lebanese sovereignty by air, sea and land, and fulfil all of its obligations under Security Council resolution 1701 (2006).

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annex issued as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 35, and of the Security Council.
