CALENDAR OF CONFERENCES FOR 1950

Note by the Secretary-General

Location of Eleventh Session of the Council

1. By Resolution 264 (IX), the Council decided that its eleventh session should be held in Geneva, commencing on 3 July 1950. The financial and administrative implications of this decision were discussed by the Fifth Committee of the General Assembly, and after consideration of the report of the Fifth Committee (A/1232), the General Assembly at its 276th meeting^{1/} in Resolution 357 (IV) resolved that:

"The Secretary-General, with the prior concurrence of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, and subject to the financial regulations of the United Nations, is authorized to enter into commitments to meet unforeseen and extraordinary expenses; provided that the concurrency of the Advisory Committee shall not be necessary for:

.....

(c) Such commitments as may be necessary to provide for expenses of meetings of the Economic and Social Council should the Council, having reconsidered the question of its place of meeting in the light of the debates in the General Assembly, confirm its decision to hold its eleventh session at Geneva;

....."

Calendar of Conferences other than Council Sessions

2. As regards the remainder of the calendar of conferences, the calendar as adjusted by the Secretary-General in consultation with the Interim Committee on Programme of Meetings, and, with respect to the session of the Commission on Human Rights, in consequence of General Assembly Resolution 356 (IV), is contained in document E/1569/Rev.1. As regards this Commission, under paragraph 3 of Part I of Section A of the budget appropriations contained in General Assembly resolution 356 (IV), no appropriation has been included in respect of a Geneva session, which consequently requires to be transferred in the calendar to headquarters.

3. When considering its agenda for the tenth session, the Council agreed with the suggestion of its Agenda Committee that this item should be taken early in the session, but should be left open till a later date insofar as might be necessary to accommodate changes in sessions of subsidiary bodies for instance, consequential upon decisions on other items of the agenda.
