PROVISIONAL QUESTIONNAIRE (T/44)**

(Redraft of additional question 36A)

Explain how the major economic development programs were carried out during the year under review. In particular, in the case of agricultural products, state:

- (a) the average prices paid to the indigenous producers;
- (b) the average prices, commissions or fees received by middlemen in the Territory;
- (c) the **average selling prices** of the commodities (i) in the world market, (ii) in the Territory, (iii) in the metropolitan country; and comparable prices received for exports from the Territory and for re-exports, if any, from the metropolitan country;
- (d) whether any company, private or public, has the exclusive or preponderant right to buy and/or sell the commodity; if so, what taxes are paid by such companies to the metropolitan and/or to the territorial authorities;
- (e) whether payments of foreign exchange earned in sales of the commodities are made in the Territory or in the metropolitan country and, if in the latter, whether there are any restrictions on transfer to the Territory;
- (f) whether under the marketing arrangements any reserve funds or stability funds have been created and how were they used.
