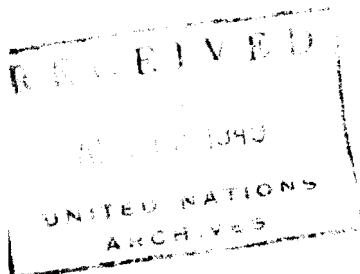

2. In its work the Group found it possible to accept and incorporate the vast majority of suggestions relating to specific items and, it is believed that as a result, the clarity and usefulness of items have been greatly improved.

/3. Individual

3. Individual countries have proposed that commodities in which they are particularly interested be shown separately and wherever this was considered feasible it has been done.
4. Comments and suggestions were also received regarding the general framework of the classification and each of these has been carefully considered. As a result the proposed classification presents the most generally acceptable framework that could be achieved in the time allotted, considering the widely divergent viewpoints expressed.
5. A few opinions were offered, as well, respecting the make-up and content of the supplementary classification by stage of production and use. The conceptual bases proposed varied widely with the result that the Group decided to retain the headings that appeared in the draft circulated.
6. To assist the Committee on Statistical Classification in its consideration of the amended classification, there follows a summary of the most important suggestions that were found unacceptable to the Group of Consultants along with the chief reason, in each case, for not following the suggested procedure. It was felt that an enumeration of the points accepted and incorporated into the revised draft was not necessary.
7. Foodst - Three comments (from F.A.O., Spain and Italy) requested a detailed breakdown of fresh fruits and nuts into individual items. The group considered these requests and decided to set up six items for fresh fruits, one item for edible nuts, two items for dried or preserved fruits, and one item for edible nut preparations. A request from Chile that pears be included with apples not acceded to on the grounds that it is desirable to keep the item "apples" clean. Italy requested separation of table from wine grapes. The group felt that this would be too difficult in practice. F.A.O. and International Bank requested that dates, now included in "other fresh fruits", should be specified as a separate item under dried fruits. The Group considered that there was merit in this suggestion, but that raisins, currents and figs had equal claims. In the interests of keeping the list within reasonable bounds, therefore, one item for dried fruits seemed to be sufficient.
8. Vegetables - Questions were raised by Canada and United Kingdom as to the desirability of showing seed potatoes separately. The Group felt that this distinction might be difficult to make in practice in most countries. F.A.O., Hungary, Turkey and International Bank suggested further subdivision of pulses; in particular the separation of human from animal feed. The Group felt that this would be difficult in practice

practice, since some of the pulses may be used as human or animal food; while internationally, the distinction cannot be made since all pulses are used for human consumption in one country or another.

9. Bacon, ham and salted pork - Hungary requested separation of bacon. The Group felt that it would be difficult for many countries to separate bacon from ham.

10. The Group decided to make a distinction between preserved meats in airtight containers and sausages not in airtight containers. Colombia and France commented that the distinction would be difficult to make. The Group decided that in general the importance of foodstuffs in airtight containers in international trade justified the segregation of such items. This has been done wherever possible.

11. Cereals n.e.s. - Turkey asked for separation of millet and canary seed. This was not considered of sufficient importance by the Group, since only a very limited number of countries would be in a position to provide separate figures.

12. Semolina - The United Kingdom asked that semolina be included with meal and flour of wheat. The group decided it was preferable to keep the item wheat flour clean and to include semolina with breakfast foods.

13. Broken rice - The United Kingdom considered that this item should be included in feeding stuffs for animals. The Group found difficulty in distinguishing between food for animals and human food in several instances. Therefore, the category "Feeding Stuffs for Animals" includes as food for animals only such items as are clearly distinguishable as animal foods. This applies in several other cases which were raised by individual countries e.g. Oats (Italy).

14. F.A.O. and International Bank asked for the separation of beet and cane sugars from beet and cane syrups and edible molasses. The Group felt that the latter items did not warrant separate specification; and, in any case, they were closely allied in use to sugar as such.

15. Several requests were received for further subdivision of fresh vegetables, particularly onions and tomatoes. The Group felt that the trade in fresh vegetables by all countries contains a great variety of types and that therefore suitable subdivisions could not be arrived at without making more items than would be practicable. At the same time, the figure for fresh vegetables as such is the significant total.

Oils

16. The United Kingdom asked that hydrogenated whale oil be included with whale oil. The Group took the view that hydrogenated oils lose their identity and can no longer be separated according to origin.

Hydrogenated oils of whatever source are in one item. /17. France

17. France wished to include soya bean, sunflower and maize oils under one item. The Group decided that soya bean oil was sufficiently important to be shown separately.

Chemicals and related products

18. Denmark asked that starchy substances be divided into foods and non-foods. The Group felt that this distinction would be difficult to make except for certain specific starchy substances, e.g., sago and tapioca, which have been included with food.

Wood and Cork

19. Sweden suggested that wet pulp be separated from dry pulp. The Group could agree that the inclusion of these in one item is not desirable when quantities are considered. Unfortunately, in a short list aggregations of items in which the unit of quantity is not very significant must occur.

Paper

20. Paper for looms - The United Kingdom suggested that articles of paper or cardboard for spinning and weaving (bobbins, tubes, jacquard cards) should be transferred to textile machinery (accessories or parts). The Group felt that it would be more logical to classify these items as paper rather than with machinery.

Textiles

21. Spain requested the separation of rayon from other textile materials. The Group felt that this was not desirable since rayon is used to a very large extent mixed with other fibres. Moreover, if this item were separated other items would also have to be considered.

Ships and Boats

22. A number of suggestions were received as to the possible division of watercraft. There was no unanimity in the proposals and the Group could not find a universally applicable basis for distinction. It was therefore decided to separate boats of less than 100 tons from the others and to establish a separate item for all combat vessels.

Miscellaneous

Denmark suggested the separation of 16 m.m. cinema film from the larger size. The Group felt that the distinction would not always be easy to make and that in any case it was not of great importance.

24. Spain asked for the separate specification of playing cards. The Group did not consider this item to be of sufficient importance to warrant separate specification.
