POPULATION CENSUS OF LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES

Resolution Adopted 15 June 1951

THE ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA,

CONSIDERING the importance of statistical data on
economically active population and labour resources; and

CONSIDERING that such statistical data can only be obtained
by means of official censuses, effected in accordance with an
adequate census programme such as that already approved by the
governments of the Latin American countries;

INVITES the governments of those Latin American countries
which have not done so to take a census of the population of
their respective territories, so as to make available
comprehensive statistical data relating to the economically
active population and the labour resources in each country.
