In a letter dated 1 July 1949 addressed to the President of the Economic and Social Council, the thirteen organizations mentioned above drew the attention of members of the Council to the desirability of retaining Article 6 of the Draft Convention for the Suppression of Traffic in Persons and of the Exploitation of the Prostitution of Women. They stress the fact that if Article 6 were to be amended or eliminated the achievement of the ends pursued by the Convention would be gravely jeopardized.

ent text of Article 6 of the Convention reads as

"Each Party to this Convention agrees to take all the necessary measures to repeal or abolish any existing law, regulation or administrative provisions by virtue of which persons who engage in or are suspected of engaging in prostitution are subject either to special registration or to the possession of a special document or to any exceptional requirements for supervision or notification."
