Dual Distribution for Council Members

Corrigendum to Document E/AC.6/SR.29

The French Delegation asked that the following corrections be made:

1. Page 17, lines 13 to 24; delete Mr. Boris's remarks and substitute the following:-

"Mr. BORIS (France) would not hesitate to vote for the Soviet Union amendment if it formed part of a series of principles to be laid down in the matter of development. That was not the case, and the Soviet Union amendment did nothing more than affirm a single principle at the head of a resolution regarding which the French delegation had already expressed its opinion by pointing out that it demonstrated the shortcomings of the Economic and Employment Commission.

For those reasons the French delegation would not vote for the Chinese delegation's amendment, which involved approval of the Commission's work in the matter of development, and would also abstain from voting on the "Soviet Union amendment."

2. Page 20, lines 8 to 13; Delete Mr. Boris's remarks and substitute the following:-

"Mr. BORIS (France), on a point of order, asked whether each representative, in addition to explaining votes given on behalf of his own country, could also claim to explain the votes of his colleagues. If so, explanations, counter-explanations, statements and denials might continue indefinitely".
