Corrigendum

1. Paragraph 3 (b), substitute "1975" for "1957".
2. Paragraph 6, second line, close parentheses after "transportation"; third line, delete parenthesis after "pipelines".
3. Paragraph 16, first line, substitute "gasoline" for "gas".
4. Paragraph 25, fourth line should begin: "Gulf Oil".
5. Paragraph 33, the following should be added:
"French Somaliland (Djibouti) imported in 1960 for bunkering 970,000 tons of petroleum products".
6. Page 27, second paragraph, the following should be added:
"In addition to internal consumption the refinery supplied bunkering of about 280,000 tons in the years 1961/62."
7. Page 28, Table 26, Item 6 should read: "Mozambique - 600,000 tons, started 1961".
8. Page 42, Table 32, Item (c) should read: "estimated for period 1960/65".
9. Paragraph 75, Item (e), delete "US\$".
10. Remark:

The total consumption for 1960 noted in many places in the report does not contain bunkering in Djibouti (French Somaliland).

The estimated future demand (1965/1975) on petroleum products does not include this bunkering as well. It is assumed, however, that Djibouti will later cover its demand from outside of the sub-region and, therefore, the forecast requirements for construction of petroleum processing units in the sub-region is not affected.
