APPLICATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF CONGO FOR ADMISSION
TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Cable dated 1 July 1960 from the Prime Minister of the Government
of the Republic of Congo addressed to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, a copy of a cable dated 1 July 1960 from the Prime Minister of the Government of the Republic of Congo concerning the application of the Republic of Congo for admission to membership in the United Nations.

In conformity with Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations, I have the honour, on behalf of my Government, to apply for the admission of the Republic of Congo to membership in the United Nations and to ask you to submit its candidature to the Security Council and to the General Assembly in accordance with the established procedure.

In the exercise of the powers vested in me, I solemnly declare that the Republic of Congo accepts without reservation the obligations stipulated in the Charter of the United Nations and undertakes to abide by the same in absolute loyalty and good faith.
