AGENDA OF THE TENTH REGULAR SESSION

Second report of the General Committee

The General Committee, at its 104th meeting held on 29 September 1955, continued its consideration of the agenda of the tenth regular session.

1. Question of West Irian (West New Guinea): item 5 of the supplementary list (A/2942)

In accordance with its decision taken at the 103rd meeting (see A/2980, paragraph 6), the General Committee considered the question of the inclusion of item 5 of the supplementary list. By 6 votes to 6, with 2 abstentions, it rejected a motion that priority in voting be given to a proposal recommending that the Assembly postpone for the time being consideration of the question of placing the item on the agenda of the tenth session. The Committee thereafter decided, by 7 votes to 5, with 2 abstentions, to recommend the inclusion of the item in the agenda; it further decided to recommend that the item be referred to the First Committee for consideration and report.

2. Measures for the further relaxation of international tension and development of international co-operation: item proposed by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (A/2981 and Add.1)

The General Committee decided, without objection, to recommend the inclusion of the item in the agenda and its allocation to the First Committee for consideration and report.
