



APPLICATION OF MOROCCO FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP  
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 17 July 1956 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs  
of Morocco addressed to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Secretary-General has the honour to transmit herewith, for the information of the Members of the United Nations, copy of a letter dated 17 July 1956 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Morocco concerning the application of Morocco for admission to membership in the United Nations.

Rabat, 17 July 1956

On behalf of His Majesty the Sultan of Morocco, and of His Government, I have the honour to transmit to you, for attachment to the application of Morocco for admission to membership in the United Nations dated 4 July 1956,<sup>1/</sup> the present declaration whereby the Government of His Majesty the Sultan accepts the obligations contained in the United Nations Charter and undertakes to fulfil them.

DECLARATION

On behalf of the Government of His Majesty the Sultan of Morocco, in my capacity as Minister of Foreign Affairs, and having submitted the application of Morocco for admission to membership in the United Nations, I declare that I accept the obligations deriving from the constitutional instrument in force and undertake to fulfil them from the date on which Morocco is admitted to membership in the United Nations.
