PERMANENT MISSIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Secretary-General

1. The present report is submitted to the General Assembly in pursuance of resolution 257 (III) of 3 December 1948, which requested the Secretary-General to "submit, at each regular session of the General Assembly, a report on the credentials of the permanent representatives accredited to the United Nations".
2. At the date of the present report the following ninety-seven Member States have set up permanent missions at the seat of the United Nations:

At the date of the present report, ninety-one Member States have appointed permanent representatives and transmitted to the Secretary-General their credentials in accordance with paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 257 A (III). During the absence of the Permanent Representative, the Government of the Dominican Republic has appointed a Chargé d'Affaires a.i. The Permanent Mission of the Congo (Léopoldville) is headed by a Chargé d'Affaires. Pending the appointment of a permanent representative, the Permanent Missions of Colombia, Cuba, Guatemala and Thailand are headed by Chargés d'Affaires a.i.

4. The following Member States, in the credentials transmitted to the Secretary-General, have authorized their permanent representatives to represent them in specified organs of the United Nations:
