APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. T.W. CUTTS (Australia)

1. At its 835th meeting the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/858) concerning a vacancy which had arisen in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the resignation of one of its members.
2. Members of the Fifth Committee had previously been invited to suggest names of persons who might be recommended for appointment to the vacancy. At the time the matter was considered by the Fifth Committee, one candidate had been proposed.
3. To decide who should be recommended for appointment, the Committee voted by secret ballot, the result of which was as follows:

Invalid ballots.	1
Number of valid ballots.	69
Abstentions	2
Number of members voting	67
Required majority.	34
Number of votes obtained:	
Mr. Antonio Arráiz.	67
4. Mr. Arráiz was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the Committee on Contributions for the unexpired portion of the term of office of the member who had resigned.

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

5. The Fifth Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The General Assembly

1. Appoints the following person as a member of the Committee on Contributions:

Mr. Antonio Arráiz

2. Declares Mr. Arráiz to be appointed for a period commencing on the date of the present resolution and ending on 31 December 1962.
