Letter dated 4 July 1956 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs
of Morocco addressed to the Secretary-General

Note by the Secretary-General: Pursuant to rule 136 of
the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the

copy of a letter dated 4 July 1956 from the Minister of
Foreign Affairs of Morocco concerning the application of
Morocco for admission to membership in the United Nations.

Rabat, 4 July 1956

On behalf of His Majesty the Sultan of Morocco and of His Government,
I have the honour to request you to be good enough to submit for the consideration
of the Security Council, at its next meeting, the application of Morocco for
admission to membership in the United Nations.

In applying for the admission of Morocco to membership in the United Nations,
the Government of His Majesty the Sultan of Morocco accepts the obligations
contained in the United Nations Charter and undertakes to carry them out.
