Letter dated 26 July 1956 from the President of the Security
Council to the President of the General Assembly

New York, 26 July 1956

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of Morocco to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 731st meeting on 20 July 1956:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Morocco,

"Recommends to the General Assembly to admit Morocco to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 731st meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of Morocco was discussed.
