ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-FOURTH REGULAR SESSION
AND ALLOCATION OF AGENDA ITEMS

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 183rd meeting, on 9 October 1969, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the Permanent Representatives of Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Lesotho, Luxembourg, Madagascar, the Netherlands and New Zealand (A/7656 and Add.1 and 2) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-fourth session of an additional item entitled "Piracy in the air".^{1/}
2. During the meeting, it was proposed that the title of the item should be amended to read: "Forcible diversion of civil aircraft in flight". On behalf of the delegations requesting the inclusion of the item, the representative of the Netherlands accepted this amendment.
3. The General Committee decided to recommend that the item, with its amended title, should be included in the agenda and allocated to the Sixth Committee.
